

Installation Instructions for Early and Late Model Tractors

BLOWER MOTOR ASSEMBLY BM3379356



STEP 1: Determine if included harness is needed

Most late model Case/IH tractors will not require the additional harness that is supplied with the blower motor. The 4-prong connection on the blower motor should plug directly into the harness on the tractor. The resistor is located in the original blower motor as well as in the BM3379356.

For early model tractors with remote resistors follow the instructions below:

STEP 3: Plug the black and brown wires (power and ground) into the harness on the tractor.

STEP 2: Connect adapter harness

Early tractor models will have a remote resistor which is made of a fiber board. Plug the adaptor harness into the 4-prong plug on the blower motor.

STEP 4: The 3-prong connection on this harness controls the speed.

White = Low, Red = Medium and Black = High.

- **A.** On some resistors you have a white, red and black wire. Just plug them into the 3-prong harness, matching up the colors.
- **B.** On some resistors you will find 3 wires of the same color. In this case you'll need to go by trial and error to determine which wire is Low, Medium and High.
